
- Raising needed funds for the parish through donations given by parishioners that the Knights collected each week.



April 10, 2020




Good Friday is a central role in the heart of Christianity and despite the stay at home executive order by the State of Florida, Knights can attend services with our families at home in unity.

Saturday, March 7, 2020




