On August 19th, Council 611 had their Officers Installation with our District Deputy Robert Billoni, assisted by District Warden Brian Foy conducting the Installation. After the installation a delicious meal of roasted chicken, green beans, mashed potatoes and gravy was served to the participants, members and their guests. August 23rd. 




