# THE 4<sup>th</sup> DEGREE REPORT

Unofficially, our Assembly 0166, is slated to host the 4th Degree Exemplification this coming fall. We'll need a lot of help organizing and preparing the Bishop Baker Center.

The Assembly established SK Allen McCaffrey (Brother AJ's father) as Color Corps Commander.

SK Mark Lynn, FL State Council Charities Director, joined our meeting and gave a short presentation. Brother Mark first pointed out GK Gabe's good job by sending emails out to the Council. It's a good way to keep everybody informed. Brother Mark is receiving about 300 envelopes a day in reference to KofC FL Charities. All Brothers should've received a letter from him. He emphasized the 12 apostles program where a Knight contributes \$12/yr or with his spouse, \$24/yr. He also explained individual donors or local Councils making a contribution to the St Michael the Archangel Fund can claim this as part of their awards program requirements for Vocations. This program supports the Knights of Columbus military chaplain scholarship programs. There are 14 seminarians in FL interested in military service. They stay in their diocese for 2-3yrs and then enter active duty for about six years. He also mentioned every Thursday Florida State Council has a virtual exemplification. Regarding Council dynamics, 12% participation is successful. So if you have 150 Knights in a Council, 18 Knights participating on a regular basis is good. Lastly, he mentioned his past recruiting success by finding recruits at children sporting events. Just bring some coffee and have conversation.


