Message from the Worthy Grand Knight

As we draw closer to Christ during this Lenten Season, let's take to heart the purpose behind our call to prayer, thoughtful preparation for penance, fasting and alms-giving. Alms-giving includes monetary support for "the least of these" in our society, but it also calls us to give of our time and talents in meaningful ways to ministry and events. In February, Council 611had several opportunities to do both. Early in the month, we received the St. Joseph Icon and made arrangements for its placement at the Cathedral of St. Augustine's altar. We strategically placed St. Joseph prayer cards near entrances and attended the Children's Mass. Our Council Chaplain, Father Ignatius, held a special 7 a.m. Mass in honor of St. Joseph. On February 10th, we hosted our first Valentines' Dinner Dance at the Bishop Baker Center. While this was a great social event, it was also a fundraiser for Florida State Special Olympics, and proceeds from the event ticket sales and the 50/50 were donated to that charity. Denise Breneman, Florida State Director of Special Olympics, was our special guest. On February 23rd, Council 611 supported the 39th Annual Cathedral Parish School's Festival by donating funds and all the manpower for their Friday night fish sandwich tent. Just two days later, on February 25th, Council 611 members purchased and served coffee and donuts after the 9 and 11 a.m. Masses. The day also included praying the Rosary prior to the 11 a.m. Mass. Council 611 has achieved it's first ever DOUBLE STAR COUNCIL status by recruiting 18 new members to our Council! During each of the last five years, we achieved Star Council Status. This achievement is not centered around one person's efforts; it was truly a council achievement. Every event, volunteer action, articles in the church bulletin, and a Knights of Columbus presence in support of our Parish and Faith has attracted new members to join our Christian organization. The increase of our Council membership ensures the good health of our Council. I have noticed an increase in attendance and participation at our Council meetings, socials, and events. An influencing factor also has been the Ladies' Auxiliary. Their numbers have also increased and they support the Knights' efforts.


