Pregnancy Center Support (Star Council Activity)

Changing hearts and minds about abortion by showing that the Knights of Columbus loves both mother and child before and after birth, Councils provide material, financial, labor and other support to pro-life pregnancy centers that help women during pregnancy and following the birth of their newborn children. More than 3000 pro-life pregnancy centers now operate throughout territories of the Knights of Columbus. By the very nature of its founding, the Knights of Columbus is called to care for the widow and orphan. Abortion-vulnerable unborn children and mothers experiencing unexpected pregnancies certainly fall within that mandate. With aid from the Knights, pregnancy centers can offer support to help women choose life.

This year First Florida Council 611 donated \$500 to the St. Gerard Pregnancy Campus on US 1 in St. Augustine.



The St. Gerard Campus is an independent, non-political, non-sectarian facility designed to assist pregnant teenagers and unwed mothers. They are prepared to provide assistance and referrals for medical care, educational needs, or job services to all women, regardless of age, marital status, race or religion. The statistics show that most unplanned pregnancies occur in the 20-29 year old age group. All of their services are provided free of charge. They provide free pregnancy testing in their Pregnancy Center, personal counseling, group counseling with parents, husband or significant other. Free sonograms are also available.

In addition, they assist with adoption and with adoption counseling, as well as, their Community Outreach Program assists with food, clothing, furniture and counseling.

They are a fully-accredited interfaith Christian High School with on-site Daycare for their students. Their Residency Program allows pregnant teenagers and their babies to live at St. Gerard Campus while attending school.

COFFEE & DONUTS SERVICE

First Florida Council 611 will continue to serve coffee & donuts after the 9am and 11am masses each Sunday in December except Sunday, December 22nd & 29th (Christmas & New Year's holiday weekends). Since September this program has already resulted in one new member and more than five brothers transferring into our Council from others. Just to recap, the Coffee & Donuts service is instrumental in:

- Raising needed funds for the parish through donations given by parishioners that the Knights collected each week.
- Engaging and exposing the Knights of Columbus to our parish community nearly each week for nine consecutive months from September through May.
- Generating leads for prospective new members by virtue of the exposure and meaningful interaction with our parishioners each week.
- The engagement itself with our fellow parishioners is a very rewarding and fun experience for each Knight that participates and volunteers.
